>OFF When any application is launched, the first thing it does is check to see whether or not it is debugging or not. If it is, then it sets a special environment variable named MDAC_Debug to a value of 1. If you're running a .NET application that uses MDAC, you can force it to always start

in Debug mode by setting the value of the environment variable. Most of the time, when an application is launched, the developer decides to start it in Debug mode, because that's the default. The developer knows if there are errors, he will be able to fix them. However, there are times when it's useful to launch an application in Debug mode, but only for a short time, so you can get a hint of what's going on inside the application before switching to the default mode. This topic explains how to force your application to start in Debug mode, and then switch to default mode as soon as possible. Force your application to start in Debug mode In the section where you listed you MDAC_Debug environment variable, type 1 and save. Note that if you don't save, your changes will be lost when you close the app. This will change the environment variable, so that all your applications launched in Debug mode will start in Debug mode. Saving the change Start your application. Make sure you are at the app's Home screen. On your keyboard, press Windows Key+R Type the name of your app and click OK. Your app should now be launched in Debug mode, and before it ends, it should leave the Debug mode. Sometime, this solution is not enough. When an application is launched, the Taskbar and Task Switcher applet window is removed from the Taskbar. So that the application will be opened in the main screen. Then the application should be removed from the Taskbar manually or start the Task Switcher applet. Auto-open (Screens) Every application that has an icon on the Taskbar is considered to be an auto-open application. Some

applications add their icons to the Taskbar without the Start button and some add a shortcut to the Start menu without adding an icon to the Taskbar.
